Materials:

- Sharpened pencil – Bring your own to use every day in class!

Assignments: (30% of final grade)

We will have various written assignments that will be assigned in and completed in class

Performance: (30% of final grade)

To showcase what has been learned in class, we will hold concerts on **February 29th** and **May 16th** at 7:30 in the school's cafetorium. The student must arrive in the cafetorium 45 minutes prior to their performance time for a pre-concert rehearsal. We also have the opportunity to perform at our District Middle School Festival during school on **March 13th** which will also be a required performance. Each member of the choir is vital and attendance and participation in each concert is mandatory.

Participation: (40% of final grade)

As each student plays an important role in choir, they are each greatly missed when they are absent from class. At the end of each week, students will fill out a self-evaluation form of their individual participation that week. Mrs. Andrews reserves the right to change the score in order to reflect the behavior and participation of each student if need be.

Concert Apparel:

Each choir student is expected to arrive at the concert at the specified call time with the following attire:

- Jeans (no holes)
- Choir t-shirt*
- Close toed shoes

This is to ensure a uniform look for our performance and help each student have the best experience.

Classroom Policies:

Music Folders – Each student will be given music and an assigned a folder number with a designated spot in the classroom. Students are responsible for grabbing their folder and sitting in their seat *before* the bell rings. Students may take their music home to practice but are responsible for bringing it to class every day.

Food – Absolutely no food, drink, or gum is allowed in the choir room except water. As this a class where we are constantly using our voices, it is unsafe to have anything in your mouth while we are rehearsing.
