Action Plan Steps and Expendituresclose

1. Replace and maintain technology resources and cover cost of on-line apps or technology subscriptions to enhance student engagement and learning.

2. Hire additional interns, teachers, or offer current teachers extended day as needed to lower class size and enhance student course offerings.

3. Augment skill building funds and facilitate targeted, individual student remediation for at-risk, ELL, special education, and struggling learners through tutors and study hall technicians.

4. Promote and provide supplies for increased opportunities for advanced learners such as Maker Spaces, Battle of the Books, math competitions, Genius Hour, Odyssey of the Mind, art competitions, dance productions, science fair, STEM programs, poetry slam, young author programs, etc.

5. Facilitate on-going faculty and staff professional development on effective teaching strategies and mastery of core standards.

6. Extend learning through field trip experience such as Topaz, Walking Utah Studies Tour, State Capitol, Planetarium, Nature Hike, Cycling Day Trip, BYU Sports Day, etc.

7. Extend learning through educational assemblies, Young Theater Company, Author visits, Stand 4 Kind, Guest speakers, etc.
