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Course Description: The sixth and seventh grade language arts standards focus on starting college and career readiness. In English, we will be using a program called Language! The Comprehensive Literacy Curriculum. This program integrates instruction in foundational skills, writing, vocabulary, fluency, grammar, comprehension, and spoken English. We also learn about the different types of writing styles (nonfiction, expository, narrative, and argumentative) and grammar usage. Students in this class will receive explicit and direct instruction to meet their individual learning goals and needs. We will work on improving our overall writing, reading and grammar skills.

<u>School Rules & Expectations:</u> Be **ALL IN** for learning! Live the Diamond Fork Values: Respect, Compassion, Courage, Integrity, Perseverance, and Curiosity.

Cellphones: There is a strict NO PHONE policy at Diamond Fork. Phones must be in your locker or backpack during class. They are allowed during lunch and in the halls during passing periods. If I see it, I will confiscate it and you will get it back at the end of the day. After two offenses, your parent or guardian will need to get it from the office.

Mrs. Davis's Class Rules & Expectations:

- 1. Be prepared- come to class with necessary supplies, a good attitude and ready to learn
- 2. Always do your best-show effort in class, participate, complete assignments, and work hard
- 3. Listen & Follow directions- Listen when the teacher is talking, follow directions the first time when given, complete tasks when asked
- 4. Respect yourself & others- Respect class materials, keep your hands to yourself, use kind language, be nice to teachers and students
- 5. Use materials appropriately- Using supplies (scissors, markers, bouncy bands, etc.) and technology like chromebooks are a privilege. Use chromebooks when allowed and stay with the class during the lesson (no surfing the internet or games).

Reading List: As a class, we will read two to three short novels according to the student's reading levels. If you have any concerns about a specific novel, please contact me and I can work with you

on an alternative. I also have a classroom library where students may check books out. While I have read many of them, I have not read all of them. If you have a concern about a specific book, please come talk to me.

Homework: Homework will not be assigned in my class. The only time students will receive homework is to make up for absences or illness.

Honesty/Integrity: Cheating in any form is unacceptable. A student who is caught cheating will receive a zero for the assignment/assessment, and will have their citizenship dropped to a "U". The student will redo the assignment/assessment for credit.

Citizenship: Students will receive a separate grade for citizenship. Your citizenship grade in this class will be based on the scale below. Citizenship can go down depending on class behavior such as participation, following directions, showing respect and respecting the other Diamond Fork Values.

S (Satisfactory) = 90-100 N (Needs improvement) = 70-89 U (Unsatisfactory) = 0-69



While you may lose points for breaking class/school rules, you can earn them back with exceptional behavior, completing work on time, and helping classmates or the teacher.

**Poor behavior for a substitute will automatically drop a student's citizenship to a "U"

Food in the classroom: There is none!!! Please do not bring any food into the classroom. Each student should have a water bottle (for water only). Exceptions include snacks that I may bring as part of an activity.

Chromebooks: We will be using Chromebooks for student learning. It is expected that students adhere to their Computer Use Agreement, which includes sanitizing after each day. All students will be trained in and required to abide by classroom procedures. Violations of the Computer Use



Agreement or classroom procedures could result in loss of citizenship and suspension of the use of the device for an established period of time. In the event of vandalism, the student will be required to pay for damages or replace the device if necessary.

Hall passes: You will be given a Diamondback Card at the beginning of each term. Once you've used your hall pass, that's it for the rest of the term. Use it wisely. Come to class prepared!

Canvas: We will be using Canva, through your child's school email for all digital assignments. This disclosure document can also be found there. Assignments can be accessed anywhere with the Internet. They can work on any of these assignments from home if not completed in class. During a quarantine, or any absence, we will continue to use the same platform for all assignments.

Attendance: Always call or email the attendance office to excuse your child, even if you have already told me. Please contact them about fixing late tardies or excused absences.

Supplies: I have basic supplies for the students to use throughout the year like craft supplies, paper and pencils. I am doing a class prize box, and if you would like to contribute anything like toys, trinkets, fidgets, squishies, stickers, or snacks please let me know as donations are appreciated.
