RECORD OF VOTES TAKEN:

- Sandy motioned to approve December's minutes
 - Ty seconded minutes approval. Voting was unanimously approved.
- Gary motioned to adjourn the meeting
 - Reilly seconded motion to adjourn. Voting was unanimously approved.

ALL MATTERS PROPOSED, DISCUSSED, OR DECIDED:

- Review of December minutes. Votes taken.
- Brenda updated the SCC on the impending changes to the Admin Team.
- Bart updated the SCC on COVID numbers
 - No longer needed to quarantine, as long as students wear masks
 - Currently in the 4-8 range
 - Discussed vaccine roll out in the district
- Brenda led discussion of School Trustlands Plan
 - Explained the changes to the School Trustlands Plan over the years
 - It's been simplified over the past year or two
 - One goal for TSSA Plan is a District-wide goal
 - Establish district-wide framework for content areas
 - Our other goal is to increase by 1% or more the number of students passing their classes and

making growth on assessments (end of level, district benchmarks, WIDA, school assessments, etc) in the core subjects of language arts/reading, math, science and other subjects.

- Discussed our supporting goals (within goal #2)
 - Implement character ed, citizenship, team time, etc
 - Implement research-based effective teaching strategies to facilitate student acquisition of college and career readiness skills.
 - Monitor class sizes and provide remediation/enrichment to facilitate improved academic achievement.
- Major focus next year in transition to middle school is using money to help pay for additional teachers.
 - With shrinking numbers, we will lose 8-9 teachers without using Trustlands money to help.
- Showed the TSSA Plan spreadsheet to the SCC and explained the funding model
- Brenda proposed using the vast majority of Trustlands money to buy down class sizes for next year.
- David expressed his agreement with Brenda's proposal.
- Brenda asked the parents to speak with other parents concerning the plan and be ready to approve next month.
